English


Our text for this term will be 'Leaf' by Sandra Dieckmann. We will be learning how to use the past tense and describe settings and

characters imaginatively. We will write our own story based on the text and information texts about animals.

Maths

We will be learning to read the time to the nearest quarter of an hour and revisiting money.

We will also continue to practise our 4 calculations using efficient methods.



The Key Instant Recall Fact (KIRF) that we will be working on is 'multiplication and division facts for the 2 times table.'

Connected Curriculum

Our topic question for Terms 5 and 6 will be 'What can we learn from other countries in the Commonwealth?' and our focus will be DT and Geography. Beech class will be developing their understanding of the British monarchy and exploring countries within the Commonwealth. We will then be designing and making a portable snack for the Queens jubilee.

PE
