




Chestnut Class Newsletter – Term 5

We hope that you have had an enjoyable and restful break. We have a wide variety of learning opportunities and experiences planned for this term and we are looking forward to sharing them with you.




English

Our text for this term will be Mary Poppins. We will be learning to write simple poetry, using paragraphs to group information and look at using the present perfect form of verbs.

Maths

We will be working on fractions at the beginning of the term, then moving on to some statistics.

The Key Instant Recall Fact (KIRF) that we will be working on is 'I can recall facts about durations of time (seconds in a minute etc.)'



Connected Curriculum

Our topic question for Terms 5 and 6 will be 'What can we learn from other countries in the Commonwealth?' and our focus will be DT and the Arts. Chestnut Class will be exploring music and art from India, as well as learning about the geographical features of the country. Our DT project will involve learning to make paper circuits. We will also design a celebration card linked to the Queen's Platinum Jubilee where the children will apply their skills and create a design with an LED.

PE
