




Chestnut Class Newsletter – Term 6

English

In English we will be reading *Albert Upside Down* which is a lovely book all about team work.

We will be working on using interesting language to engage readers, apostrophes for singular possession and developing a plot in a narrative.



Maths

We will be finishing our learning on fractions this week and the moving onto interpreting data. Next, we will then be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and angles and measurement of mass and length. We will finish our learning this year in maths looking at time. Our The Key Instant Recall Fact (KIRF) that we will be working on is the 8 times tables. We will also be consolidating all our other times tables too. Practice of these at home is greatly appreciated.

Connected Curriculum

Our topic question for Term 6 will continue to be 'What can we learn from other countries in the Commonwealth?' and our focus will be DT and the Arts. We will be developing the skills of a designer to create a vegetable soup using spices and practising our knife cutting skills to create a smoothie. As artists, we will be looking at rangoli patterns and exploring different techniques to create effects using different mediums.

PE

PE will take place on Monday and **Thursday**. Please ensure that your child wears the correct PE kit to school on these days. This includes a **plain** house-coloured t-shirt, plain black tracksuit bottoms/leggings and trainers. The normal Elm Park sweatshirt or PE hoodie must be worn.
