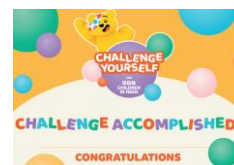
Both evenings were very well attended and it was wonderful to have the opportunity to talk about the children's learning, celebrate their achievements and discuss their next steps for the term ahead.
